Impact on SEAMO

All Phase III money to be paid by March 31

- The OMA and the Ministry (“the Parties”) acknowledge that allocation mechanisms are far from perfect
- Most complaints are about “clinical repair”, which is 25% of total \$250 mm
- Clinical repair calculations to be revisited in two years

SEAMO calculation

- Ministry and SEAMO FTE numbers are not the same
- Ministry and SEAMO notional rate and total income numbers are not the same
- Ministry site visit on Friday to attempt reconciliation

Funding agreement to be extended

- Ministry to offer extension to the current funding agreement
 - Extended one year or until new Framework Agreement, whichever comes first
 - New funding (Phase III) to be included in extension
 - New accountability provisions
 - ? New governance provisions

Recruitment funding

- Phase III contains one-time funding to support new recruits from outside Ontario
- Without ffs, how would this work in SEAMO?

Clinical repair

- Most contentious issue
- Now 86% of community mean ffs compensation
- Revisited in 2 years
- Will shadow billing be used in existing AFDs in 2 years time?
- Recognition some groups not well served by these comparisons

Oncology APPs

- Two Kingston Oncology APPs expected to access Phase III funding only through SEAMO
- Feb 29 as deadline for written agreement and for Onc's to sign D&C
- No appropriate D&C as yet developed for Kingston context

GST

- Will academic fund attract GST, either at transfer to practice plans or at transfer to individual?
- OMA counsel would not offer an opinion
- OMA counsel recommended that each APP/AFP and each practice plan seek independent advice

Oversight Committee

- Now to be called “Academic Medicine Steering Committee”
- Five members
- Co-chaired by PSC co-chairs, or designates
- Other members to include:
 - COFM rep
 - CAHO rep
 - Governance chairs rep
