

## ACDD UPDATE MEDICAL EDUCATION RECOMMENDATIONS ENDORSED

At its regular meeting, February 05, the SEAMO Governing Committee accepted the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Departmental Deliverables (“ACDD”) as they apply to undergraduate education deliverables. This new policy will require the Undergraduate Medical Education Office to calculate education requirements, including direct contact with learners and indirect requirements. A committee will be established to assign undergraduate education responsibilities to departments. Compliance with assigned education responsibilities will be measured and there will be financial implications for departments with regard to these assigned responsibilities. ## SEAMO GOVERNING COMMITTEE TO ESTABLISH NEGOTIATIONS PREPARATION COMMITTEE

Although negotiations with SEAMO with regard to a new multi-year funding agreement will not commence until the Ministry and the Ontario Medical Association have completed negotiation on a new framework agreement, the SEAMO Governing Committee, will establish a negotiations preparation committee to advise Governors and SEAMO management with regard to the specific issues that SEAMO may wish to bring to the table.
